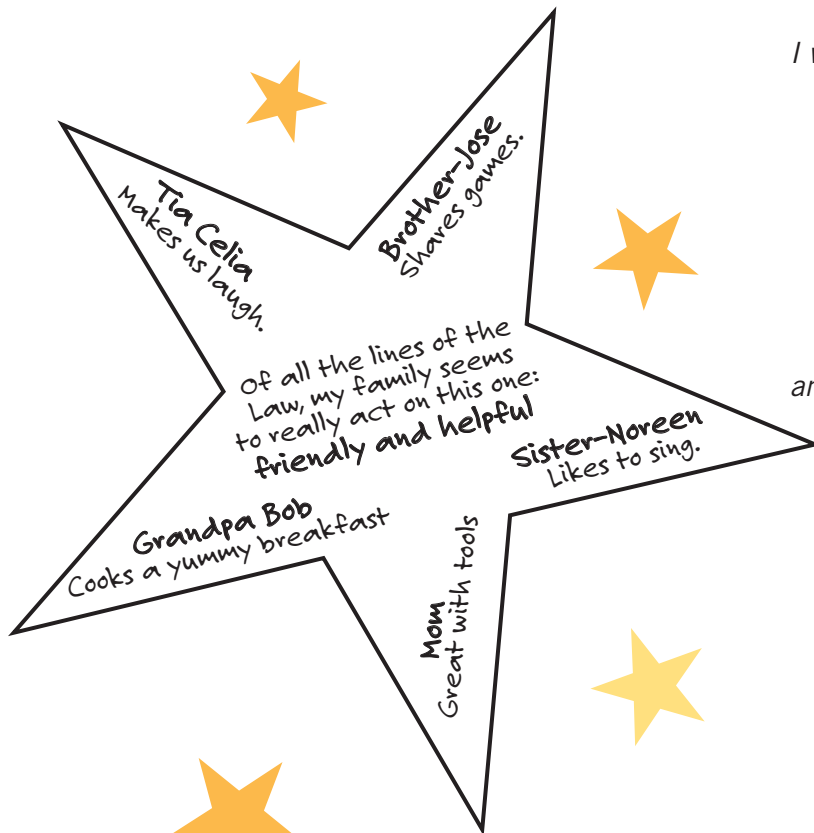


Making a Family Star
